

PROBLEM.

For parents trying to help children with mental health issues, their common experience is that it is **difficult to find the right help**. It is not an easy job to raise children, and when children are facing mental health or substance use challenges, the **difficulties** can be **overwhelming**.

Less than one third of B.C.'s children and youth with mental illness find the help they need. The impact can be devastating. They **struggle** and they **suffer**. Tragically, some even give up all hope.

When referred to a psychiatrist the wait can be up to a year.

- **\$125 an Hour.**

If you choose a private psychologist or social worker, these services are not covered by MSP and can cost \$125/hour or more.

Navigation of available care, services and resources is frustrating and traumatizing for families as they have to re-tell their story over and over before they can access the help they really need.

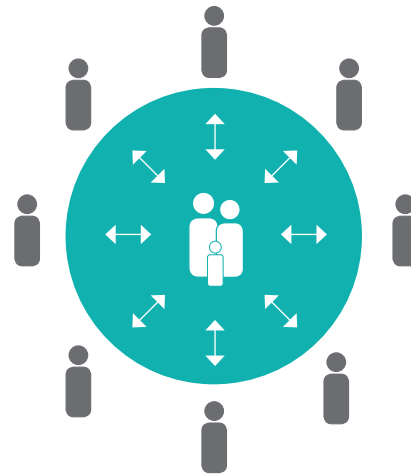
